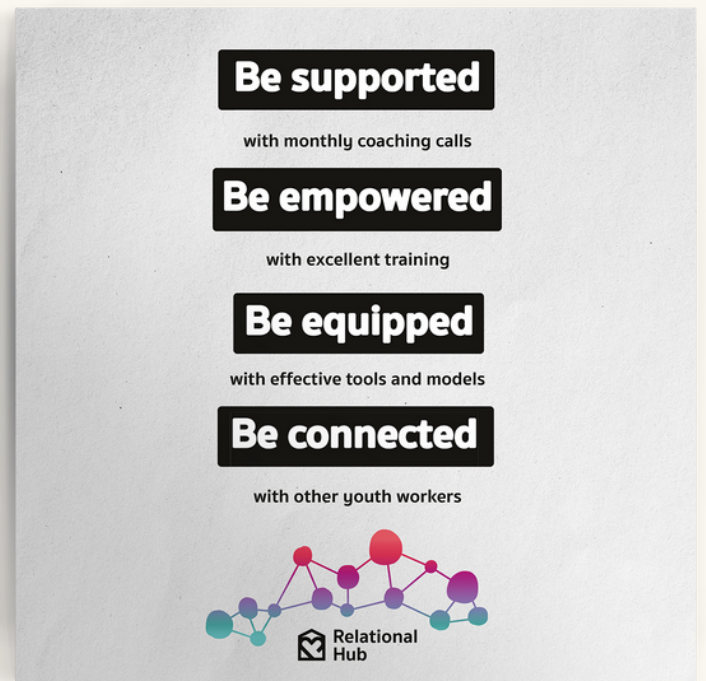

4 MAIN ELEMENTS

ONE

COACHING

Our monthly coaching calls give the opportunity for project leads to check-in and discuss any challenges with one of the RH team as well as being guided through our resource library of project management templates.

TWO

TRAINING

Our termly online & annual in-person (CYWS) training is topic based & co-produced with the Collective to make sure it cutting through to their frontline delivery. We will often bring in experts to deliver the sessions.

THREE

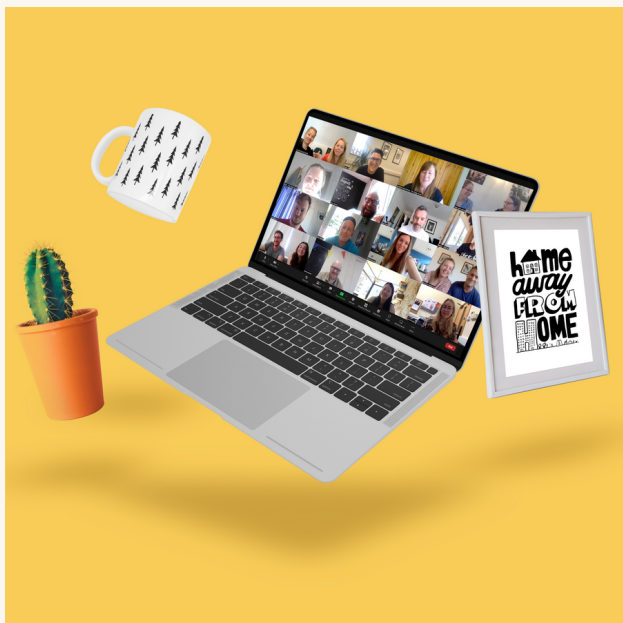
TOOLS

Our youth work tools are adopted from the organisations we support and have a track record of being effective in improving our work with young people and evidencing progress.

FOUR

PEER TO PEER

We facilitate regular visits for Collective members to be inspired by other projects in the Collective. We also have our Collective WhatsApp group for youth workers to connect with each other.



ONLINE TRAINING

Our termly online training covers topics that cut through to the frontline of youth work, such as: The Drama Triangle, County Lines, Trauma Responsive Support, Understanding Eating Disorders, Tackling Challenging Behaviour, and much more. Any of your paid or voluntary team can access the sessions.

CYWS

The Community Youth Workers Summit is our annual in-person training day. A unique opportunity for youth workers and pastoral workers to come together to celebrate the invaluable contribution you bring in supporting young people. As part of the Collective any of your team can attend for a subsidised cost.



VISITS

We regularly facilitate visits for your youth workers to learn and be inspired by the work of other organisations within the Collective. This is a great time to benchmark your work and discover different ways of working that are making a positive impact to young people in a different region of the UK.

Leadership Training.



Our bi annual Leadership Training Courses are run by Moringa, who deliver world class training courses to our Collective members. As Moringa are a B-Corp they offer their training to our members at a subsidised rate. We have found the training to make a huge impact to the youth workers who have taken part over the past few years.

As a charity ourselves we are fully aware of the challenges with making a project sustainable and with our support we believe your organisation will make an even greater sustainable impact in future years.

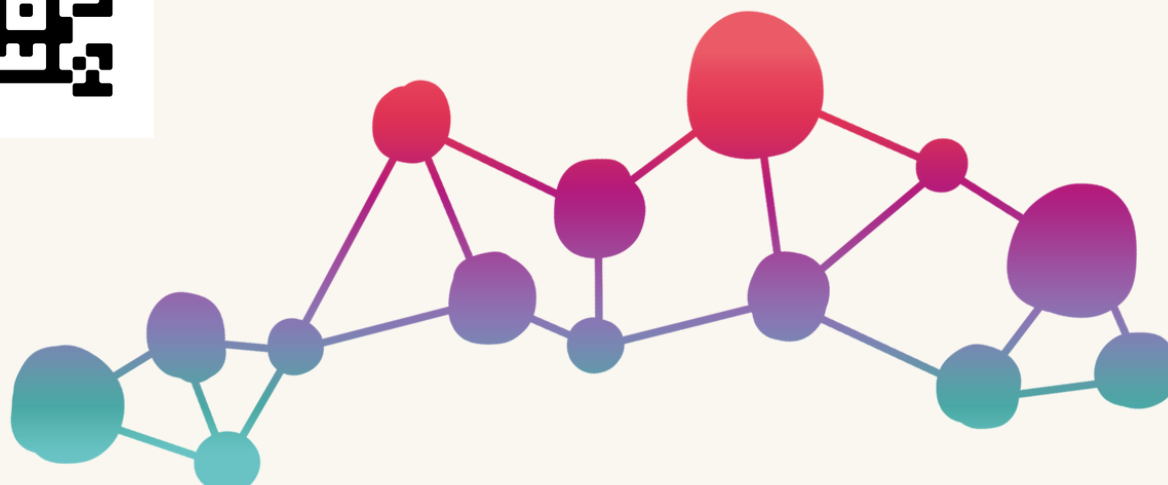


The next step to join the RH Collective is to sign our Collective Agreement and let the support begin
